**access to the Ballet School is not allowed if:**

- in the previous fourteen (14) days my child/ward has exhibited flu-like symptoms or symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (fever of any duration, coughing, shortness of breath, runny nose, sore throat, diarrhea, alterations of taste or smell);
- in the previous fourteen (14) days my child/ward has come into close contact with persons who have tested positive for COVID-19 or have shown symptoms consistent with COVID-19;
- my child/ward is subject to quarantine or isolation at home;
- in the previous fourteen (14) days my child/ward has been outside of Italy or spent time in zones with announced COVID-19 risk;
- my child/ward exhibits flu-like symptoms or has a fever (above 37.5°C / 99.5°F).

**NB**

- In the event of suspicious symptoms (fever, fatigue, muscle pain, altered taste or smell), immediately notify your family general practitioner (medico di medicina generale) so that diagnostic tests may be performed and evaluated by the Academy physician.
- In the event of contact with family members or other persons exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19, even if your child/ward has not been placed in quarantine, consult the Academy physician via the Ballet School Office before allowing your child/ward to attend the Workshop;
- If your child/ward has been in situations that may have exposed him/her to risk of contagion (gatherings, close and unprotected contact with third persons, events or meals in close contact with other people, etc.) discuss conditions for beginning the Workshop with the Academy physician.

NOTICE PER GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (EU) 2016/679

The Initial Attendance Declaration will be stored for a maximum of fourteen (14) days after the last day that the Student accesses Fondazione Accademia Teatro alla Scala facilities

The data communicated via the Initial Attendance Declaration and any medical information deriving from medical or diagnostic exams performed after said Declaration:

- are collected for the purpose of protecting the student and Academy staff and other students from the risk of contracting COVID 19 in observance of the provisions in the *“Common regulatory protocol for measures to prevent and contain the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus in workplaces”* (*“Protocollo condiviso di regolamentazione delle misure per il contrasto e il contenimento della diffusione del virus Covid-19 [sic] negli ambienti di lavoro”*) signed on March 14, 2020 by the social partners, revised and updated on April 24, 2020, and including any subsequent revisions and/or updates;
- will be processed by the Academy physician pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679.

In particular

- the Academy physician will communicate data to the Office of the Director of the Academy that are indispensable for the protection of the student and Academy staff and other students from the risk of contracting COVID-19; regarding “at-risk” students, only those data necessary to fulfill the objective of requesting special protections for said students will be communicated to the Office of the Director of the Academy; in any case, the Academy physician will not communicate to the Office of the Director of the Academy any specifics, causes, or clinical origins of any risk factors or current or past pathologies regarding the student;
- The student’s parent(s) or legal guardian will be advised in advance of any data regarding the student to be communicated by the Academy physician to the Office of the Director of the Academy.
